6. The subject of Environmental studies will be mandatory at all the under graduate levels in compliance to the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court Of India.
7. A minimum of 10 students shall be admitted by the university in each course.
8. To initiate the process for NAAC accreditation (if eligible) with in next three months.
9. That the university shall also be on board for accreditation for other agencies like NBA etc.
10. That the all the details as mandatory disclosures under the provisions of Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006 shall be available on the website of the university along with the number of allotted seats in each course.
11. The university should also be on board on NAD as well within next three months.

It was further directed that it will be mandatory for the university to upload the following information's on the website of the University:-

- (a) The details of Grievance Redressal Mechanism along with the name and contact details of the officer concerned shall also be available on the web site.
- (b) Number of courses being run at the university with the details of the letter issued by the department w.r.t the NOC granted and other permissions granted by a regulatory authority.
- (c) Name, qualification, Aadhar number and designation of each faculty member

(d) Information about the mode of admissions (based on Marks or Entrance examination in case of technical and professional courses only as per the provisions under the Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006) pudghehry@gmail.com

(e) Number of admitted students in each course along with the details about students of Haryana domicile, scholarship granted, fee concession given, etc. as per the provisions made under the Haryana Private University Act, 2006

(f) The Aadhar number of every student.

(g) Aadhar seeded Bank account number of students where scholarship of any kind is provided.


