- d. Starex University shall be responsible for obtaining NOC required for running the Department of Physiotherapy.

4. TERM

- I. This MOU shall become effective from ("Effective Date") and shall continue to remain in force for a period of 5 years from the Effective Date unless terminated earlier in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement.
- II. Upon the expiry of this MOU, the same may be extended/renewed in writing, on the terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

5. TERMINATION

- I. This MOU may be terminated by either Starex University or Star Hospital at any time, with or without cause, by giving written notice to the other party not less than thirty (30) days before the effective date of termination, provided that, in the event of a termination for cause, the breaching party shall have the right to cure the breach within the notice period.
- II. Upon issuance of the notice of termination:
 - i. The parties shall not create any further obligations with respect to the terms of this MOU.
 - ii. Both parties shall fulfil their respective obligations and commitments that may have arisen before the date of notice of termination. This will include the completion of the education of the existing/current batch and both the Parties shall comply with the respect agreed obligations in this regard as per the terms of the MOU.
 - iii. Termination of this MOU shall be without prejudice to any of the rights and obligations already accrued to the Parties till the effective date of termination of this MOU.
