The approval shall be subject to the following conditions:-

- The eligibility criterion for admission to undergraduate and post graduate programmes, number of seats in each programme/course and the duration of courses should be in line with the norms and regulations of UGC and other regulatory authorities.
- The faculty to be engaged should be well qualified, and as per UGC norms and regulations.
- Choice Based Credit System shall be mandatory and communication skills, information technology skills and basic mathematics must be included in the curriculum for all students. The core subjects and the elective subjects should be well defined before starting the new course
- The aforementioned amendments shall be incorporated and the necessary changes may also be made so as to make the new programmes more effective and viable
- The number of faculty members to be engaged shall also be in accordance with the UGC guidelines/ norms and these details must be prominently displayed on the website of the University.
- The subject of Environmental studies will be mandatory at all the under graduate levels in compliance to the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court Of India.
